





Have you heard of the Nobel Prize? Most people have. Nobel Prizes are given to people who do something good for the world. There are Nobel Prizes for peace, physics, chemistry, medicine, literature and economics. They are awarded each year. The winners get a medal and 10 million Swedish kronor. That is about 100 million yen.

There is another award you may not have heard of. It is the *Ig Nobel* Prize. This is a joke award. It is given to people who do something to make people laugh and also make them think. The Nobel Prize was named after Alfred Nobel, a Swedish scientist. The word 'noble' means 'a person of high quality.' 'Ignoble' means 'not noble.' One of the awards recently was given to scientists who tested hanging rhinos upside down.



The scientists wanted to know if hanging rhinos upside down was bad for the rhino's health. This seems ridiculous and funny, but to move a rhino, people use a helicopter. The scientists wanted to know if the rhino was better upside down or on its side. The result was it is healthier to hang a rhino upside down than carry it on its side. Next the scientists wanted to test other animals.

Other Ig Nobel Prizes were for economics: research into if how fat a country's politicians were was connected to how corrupt they were; and for physics: researching why pedestrians don't always bump into other pedestrians. The prize for an Ig Nobel was 100,000,000,000 Zimbabwean dollars this year. This was about 40 yen!


